



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR **SAHARA**

SPOT CLEANING: USE A MILD DETERGENT AND FORCEFULLY BLOT THE STAIN CONTINUOUSLY, PULLING THE LIQUID AND STAIN OUT OF THE FABRIC WITH A DRY, CLEAN, PAPER TOWEL OR CLOTH. WET AS NEEDED AND DO NOT RUB. IRONING MAY BE NEEDED TO REACTIVATE STAIN RESISTANT PROPERTIES AFTER WETTING AN AREA. NEVER RUB. NEVER USE BLEACH.

- **INK:** SOAK IN MILK, OR USE 2/3 CUP OF SOAP AND 1/3 CUP OF AMMONIA MIXTURE. PRESS THE SPOT AS INSTRUCTED FOR SPOT CLEANING
- **BLOOD:** RINSE IMMEDIATELY IN COLD WATER
- **FRUIT, COFFEE, TEA AND CHOCOLATE:** USE 1/3 CUP RUBBING ALCOHOL, 1/3 CUP WHITE VINEGAR AND 1/3 CUP AMMONIA. FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPOT CLEANING
- **CANDLE WAX:** SCRATCH OFF DRIED WAX, ABSORB RESIDUE WITH BLOTTING PAPER AND WARM IRON
- **GREASY STAINS (TOMATO JUICE, ETC):** BLOT WITH AMMONIA AS NEEDED TO GET STAIN FULLY WET. PULL OUT MOISTURE WITH A DRY WHITE CLOTH OR TOWEL
- **RED WINE:** WET IMMEDIATELY WITH SPARKLING WATER OR WHITE WINE AND FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPOT CLEANING
