## CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

### PIGMENT DYED

Pigment dye is a special dye technique which gives a unique finish to the fabric. The pigments are attached with the use of a binder and locked onto the surface of the fabric. This is why the fabric needs to be handled with extra care when it comes to spot cleaning. Pigment-dyed fabrics do not handle well with rubbing, especially when wet.

#### **PLEASE FOLLOW THE BELOW CARE INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Please blot with dry cloth to soak up fluid ASAP and prevent it from penetrating the fabric further/drying up.
- Do not rub or use excessive pressure while blotting!
  
- If the stain persists, blot gently with a mild, universal cleaning agent (diluted or undiluted with water.)
- Do not use a bleaching agent!
  
- In case the fabric remains stained, dry cleaning is the only option..
- For harsh stains (such as dirt, foods like chocolate, oil-based fluids, etc...) dry cleaning is the only option.
