



CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS FOR PALLADIUM

BRUSH OFF DIRT AND RESIDUE BEFORE IT BECOMES EMBEDDED INTO FABRIC. ANY SPILLS SHOULD BE CLEANED AS SOON AS THEY OCCUR WITH A WHITE CLOTH. SET-IN RESIDUE MAY REQUIRE PROFESSIONAL CLEANING.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Use a dry, soft-bristle brush or vacuum cleaner to frequently dust and remove dirt from the fabric before it becomes embedded.

EVERYDAY STAINS (mustard, coffee, red wine, butter, etc.)

- Use a mild cleaner, such as Dawn®, diluted in lukewarm water 1/4 cup per gallon. Sponge briskly and rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- On outdoor cushions, tip cushions on their sides with the zipper facing down and unzipped to ensure that all water drains.
- Air dry

MOLD & MILDEW

- In one gallon of water, mix 1 cup bleach with ¼ cup of Dawn®.
- Spray solution on entire area and allow to soak for 15 mins, sponge briskly and rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove all soap residue.
- Air dry

INK OR MARKERS

- In one gallon of water, mix ¼ cup of chlorine bleach. Spray solution over the stain, wait three hours for stain to dissolve.
- Clean the area with a dry white cloth to absorb excess liquid.
- Air dry
